

GC30 Central America (1984C215.01)

WHEREAS the right to self-determination of the Central American people is threatened by US policy in the region; and

WHEREAS the increasing militarization of the region threatens to plunge Central America into a regional war:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

THAT the 30th General Council of The United Church of Canada, through its Secretariat, urge the Canadian government to:

- STRONGLY and publicly condemn all military intervention in Central America especially
 the evident military intervention of the United States of America; and call for the
 withdrawal of all foreign troops;
- 2. COMMEND the Canadian government for opening an \$18 million dollar line of credit to the government of Nicaragua and urge the extension of new lines of credit to the government of Nicaragua;
- 3. OPEN an Embassy in Nicaragua so that there may be better lines of communication between the two countries.
