

GC31 Government Aid (1986G513)

True Document Date: August 21, 1986

That the 31st General Council take appropriate measures through its Executive to urge the Federal Government of Canada to:

- 1. Urge the Canadian government to restore 1990 as the latest date by which it commits itself to reach the target of 0.7% of Gross National Product for its international development assistance expenditures;
- 2. Monitor such expenditures to insure that projects are technically appropriate to the culture situation and have basic local acceptance;
- 3. Direct a larger portion of such assistance to be funded through Canadian nongovernmental organizations (NGOs);
- 4. Maintain a policy whereby such NGOs are not treated as agents of government, nor as extensions of government policy and [government-to-government] assistance.
